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Project Priority Setting

- Board members were asked to look at the project idea spreadsheet and rank projects 1-5.
- Two main categories were created: statewide projects and individual grants.
- Four big areas were identified:
 - 911 Resource Center
 - GIS (mapping) support
 - Language accessibility (translation/ transcription services).
 - Local authority grants (flexible funding for local needs)
- There was discussion about public education. Some members thought it was less impactful than direct support to 911 centers, while others felt it was still valuable.
- There was agreement across the Board that project submissions need more details (not just titles) before funding decisions are made.
- Local requests (like Eagle and Bent County GIS) may not be fully covered by statewide funds, so local grants could help.

Funding Request Policy

- In regard to the grant process, the Board decided that using a simple, structured template would potentially be good. Applicants would apply under new rules.
- For policy work, drafting may be done by the Board in the future but sunshine laws are being reviewed.
- It was decided that projects must be clear on needs, costs, and impact. Some projects may only receive partial funding.
- Applicants must certify funds won't replace existing budgets. Some budget information may be required.
- Unused funds will be handled case-by-case.
- An annual report is required by CRS; all grants and amounts may be published for transparency.
