Call to Order:

Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes

- Minutes from January 29 and February 11 were approved.

Public Comment Policy

- A 15-minute public comment period will be set aside at meetings.
- No public comments were made during this meeting.

Website Updates

- Discussion on simplifying language for public understanding while keeping details in the bylaws.
- Edits were suggested, including specifying that the 9-1-1 fee applies to all phone service users.
- After discussion, the board agreed on final wording and moved to adopt the language for the website.
- Motion to adopt the language was made by Lynn Notarianni, seconded by Andrew Dameron.
- Motion passed with no objections.

Bylaws Review

- The board agreed to table the discussion until the next meeting to give members more time to review documents.

Board Comments:

SB25-031 Emergency Alert Bill Discussion

- Concerns were raised about a proposed emergency alert bill and its funding implications.
- The bill's language was changed from "shall fund" to "may fund," providing flexibility.
- Concerns were raised about setting a precedent where 911 enterprise funds could be used for legislative mandates instead of board priorities.
- Some board members noted that there is misinformation about available funding.
- The board discussed the importance of prioritization for future funding decisions.
- Kirsten Grooms noted the board appears to have the authority to make such decisions, but advised setting limits and making decisions for good reasons.
